Norton Radstock Classic Vehicle Club Data Protection Policy

In order to protect the personal data given by members, Norton Radstock Classic Vehicle Club (NRCVC) follows his policy on the collection and use of members' data.

When a person joins the NRCVC we request the following data on a membership form:-

- Name
- Address
- Telephone numbers
- Email addresses
- Car details make, model & year of manufacture
- Insurance details

Members need only give their name. Other information is optional.

Members will be asked to tick a box on the form if they do not consent to their information being used for the purposes detailed in this policy.

If consent is given it will be deemed to continue until the member requests their information not to be used or to be deleted. Providing consent is given, members will be included on the NRCVC emailing list for all club notices and related club information. Should consent not be given no notices or related club information will be emailed.

The information given on the NRCVC membership form may be shared with other club members for the organisation of events, but will not be given to any person or organisation outside of the club without the express permission of the member.

Members will be notified immediately if their information has been accessed illegally.

NRCVC will remove all or part of the information held at the request of the member.
